POLICY RESOLUTION NO 25

- Topic Register of Licensed Surveyors
- Subject Recognition of Service

Policy In relation to recognising the service of Licensed Surveyors, to the profession and industry, the Board has resolved to -

- 1. Consider recognising Licensed Surveyors who have provided :
 - Over 40 years of service to the industry
 - Between 30-40 years of service to the industry
 - Between 20-30 years of service to the industry
- 2. Define service as a combination of effort, achievements obtained whilst practising as a registered Licensed Surveyor, and other activities that have contributed to the development and promotion of the profession and industry.
- 3. Consider service, as a Licensed Surveyor, to be over multiple periods
- Consider recognising the service of a Licensed Surveyor who has satisfied one of the above periods or categories, and is no longer registered.
- 5. Recognise service 30 years and over, with a personalised letter from the Board, a Certificate of Recognition of Service, and be posted on the Surveyors Board Website under "Distinguished Service to the Profession and Industry"
- Note that the personalised letter may include information such as amount of surveys lodged, milestones, work history and images
- 7. Recognise service less than 30 years with a Certification of Appreciation of their services from the Board.
